2007 High Holidays Parking Guide

VIA TRI-MET BUS OR MAX:

The Tiffany Center is located at Southwest 14th and Morrison. MAX, the Portland light rail, travels westward up Morrison from the downtown bus mall and has stops on 10th Street (Galleria) and 18th Street (PGE Park). From Hillsboro, MAX travels eastward down Yamhill and stops at 18th Street (PGE Park), and on 9th Street (Central Library).

From the downtown bus mall you can take either Bus 15 (NW 23rd to Gordon/Thurman) or Bus 51 (Vista to Dosch) to 14th Street and Morrison, within the Fareless Square Zone. Fareless Square is bounded by the Willamette River, NW Irving, and 1-405, as well as across the Steel Bridge to the Lloyd District, which includes four MAX stations: Rose Quarter, Convention Center, NE 7th Ave., and Lloyd Center; and buses that travel on Multnomah Blvd east to 13th. This provides free public transit from many local parking areas. More about transportation at: www.trans.ci.portland.or.us.

Tri-Met allows you to pay with a pre-purchased ticket, pass, or cash (exact change). Visit the trip planner on the web at www.trimet.org or call 238-RIDE for information about the best route from your home, ticket purchase information, fares and schedules.

METERS

Local meters range from 90 min. to 5 hours. Past that limit, you must move your car or it will be subject to citation, *even if you have added more coins*. Meters are \$1.25/hr. Hours are Mon.-Sat., 8:00am to 7:00pm, free on Sundays. Green kiosks accept Visa/MC (debit or credit), and the Smart card with a \$1 min.

GARAGES AND LOTS

The information below is the currently posted rates at the lots, all subject to change.

1. 1ST Presbyterian Church at 1200 SW Alder, City Center operates their parking garage from 7:30am-10:30pm (later on Thursday-Saturday). Evenings and weekends \$3. Monday-Friday \$3 per hour with a daily max of \$8.50. (Visa/MC/debit accepted).

2. DeLuxe Hotel SW 15th between Taylor and Yamhill. The charge is \$3/hr. (max \$10/day). Daily rate \$6.95 if in by 10:30am (very few daily spots available). \$3/evenings after 5pm. Visa/Mastercard accepted (\$5 minimum).

3. U-Park at the Morrison Plaza, SW 14th between Morrison and Alder (outside parking). Weekdays after 5:00pm only and all day on weekends for \$3. Visa/Mastercard accepted.

4. Smart Park on SW 10th between Yamhill and Morrison. The charge is \$1.25/hr. for the first four hours, then \$3/hr. afterwards, max \$10/weekday and \$5/weekend day. Evenings \$2 after 6pm. Parking is open on Monday-Thursday 7:00am-midnight, Friday-Saturday 7:00am-3:00am, and Sunday 9:00am-10:00pm. Visa/MC accepted.

5. U-Park on Washington between 13th and 14th. Weekdays, \$8.25/day if you are in by 10:30 am, otherwise \$3.50/hour. Evenings after 4 pm \$5, and weekends \$3. Visa/MC accepted.

6. City Center Parking on SW 14th between Burnside and Couch. Pay to park all hours, 24 hrs/day, for \$5.95. The lot is attended from 7 -9am. All other times, the auto-pay meter accepts coins or Visa/MC. Cars in the garage after 6:00 pm will need to obtain a security code, needed when you pick up your car. For more info call 503-294-3275 or 503-294-3811 and reference lot #34.

7. City Center Parking on SW 12th at Yamhill. Weekdays \$8.50 if in by 9:30 am; \$6.95 per day after 9:30 if lot is unattended. Evenings after 5 pm and weekends \$4 when lot is unattended. Visa/MC accepted.

8. Washington Service Garage on SW 13th and Washington. Weekdays, 10:30am to 4:30pm: \$2.00 for the first half hour, \$2.00 for the second half hour, \$4/hr. for each additional hour; maximum varies depending on day. Weekday early bird price (before 10:30 am) is \$7.25/day. Eves. after 4:00pm and all day on weekends is usually \$5/car. Visa/MC accepted.

9. Salmon Street U-Park (between 12th and Main). \$3.75/hr. \$8.75 max/day if in by 9:30 am. \$4/evenings after 4 pm and weekends.
