BIKE THERE???

We hope so. The easiest way is to take the Springwater Corridor Trail south from underneath the Hawthorne Bridge (ya' know near OMSI). When you get to SE Spokane just past Oaks Park, you are there. The park is also easily accessible via the Sellwood neighborhood or the Sellwood bridge.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS:

From the **WESTSIDE**: Take the Sellwood Bridge turn left on SE 6th Ave, left on Spokane and right on Oaks Parkway.

From the **EASTSIDE**: Take SE McLoughlin to SE Tacoma turn right on SE 6th Ave, left on Spokane and right on Oaks Parkway (or access it from SE 13th to Spokane).

Potluck begins immediately following Tashlich.

We will walk to Sellwood Park via SE Spokane to SE Grand Ave which deadends at Picnic Area B.
